



2017 Waconia Parks & Recreation Adult Men's Doubleheader Softball League Registration Packet

The men's softball league starts Wednesday, May 3rd, 2017 and will run every Wednesday for 12 weeks. A playoff tournament will follow completion of the regular season. Games will be at 7:00pm, 8:00pm, & 9:00pm each week. Each team will play two games every week.

An informational meeting will be held on Thursday, March 16, 2017 at 7pm at the Waconia Ice Arena, 1250 Oak Ave, Waconia.

All men's teams will be sanctioned through American Softball Association (ASA).

REGISTRATION DATES:

Team registrations are currently being accepted through Waconia Parks and Recreation located at Safari Island Community Center (1600 Community Drive) in Waconia for the 2017 Waconia Softball Leagues.

- 1) *Registrations will be processed on a first come first serve basis beginning Thursday, March 15, through Friday, April 15, 2017. A \$150 player conduct fee is due at time of registration. This \$150 player conduct fee is non-refundable until the end of the season. The \$570 team registration fee is due on first night of league play.*
- 2) *ALL paperwork & payments must be turned in to be considered registered.*

LEAGUE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

All Players Must be at least 18 years of age by May 3rd, 2017.

REGISTRATION FEES:

The registration fee for the 2017 Summer Adult Softball League will be \$570 plus a \$150 refundable player conduct fee for the Men's League. This fee includes:

- Game Balls
- ASA Sanctioning Fees
- ASA State Tournament Entry Bid- 1st place team
- Field lighting
- Umpire Fees
- Scorebooks/Scorecards
- Field User/Field Maintenance Fees

PLAYER CONDUCT FEE:

Team will forfeit their player conduct fee if a player on your team is ejected from game, involved in any altercation with another person on the Brook Peterson Park property (fighting/attempting to injure/throwing punch) or displays unsportsmanlike behavior during any league play or tournament games. This fee will be refunded to team managers by October 1st, 2017 if there are no conduct violations.

ROSTER SIZE LIMITS:

Rosters are limited to a maximum of twenty (20) players for Summer League play. Only the 20 players listed on the roster form will be eligible to participate in ASA State post-season tournaments.

GAME SCHEDULES & FIELDS:

These will be available via email beginning on Monday, April 25th. League play begins May 3, 2017. If the schedules are ready before April 25th, Team Captains will be notified via email. Please pick up your schedule at Safari Island OR provide me with your email address and I will email the schedule. Game schedules will be available shortly thereafter on www.waconia.org under City Recreation-Safari Island-Sports Leagues-Softball.
